



# Baggage policies

## Checked Baggage



Each passenger has the right to transport up to 23 kilograms. With the exception of the Pedasí route, whose permitted weight is 12 kilograms. With exception of the Fare "E" Econo Basic that you can carry luggage in the hold for an additional cost. que puede llevar equipaje en bodega por un costo adicional.

## Not Allowed Baggage

Due to their condition, the following items are considered dangerous goods and may affect the safety of the flight, therefore they cannot be carried as checked or hand luggage.

- Incendiary or explosive materials.
- Flammable liquids such as gasoline, oils, alcohols, paint, ether, solvents.
- Oxidizing materials such as calcium chloride, peroxide, ammonium nitrate-based fertilizers.
- Toxic or infectious substances such as poison, pesticides, weed killers, insecticides, or organic substances of the viral type.
- Items with poisonous or flammable gases such as butane, oxygen or liquid nitrogen.
- Radioactive material.
- Chlorine tanks, oxygen, fire extinguishers.

# Excess Baggage Charge

The weight allowed is 23 Kgs (50lbs) per suitcase. With the exception of the Pedasí route, whose permitted weight is 1 suitcase of up to 12 kilograms.

A surcharge for excess baggage over the kilograms allowed will be applied at a rate of \$5.00 per extra kg with a minimum payable of \$25.00.

The additional piece up to a maximum of 23 Kgs will be invoiced at a rate of \$35.00 per piece, you may carry a maximum of 2 additional pieces. If the maximum amount is exceeded, it may be sent as Cargo (Terms and conditions for cargo may apply).

NOTE: All excess baggage is accepted as conditioned baggage and will be subject to available space within the aircraft. If space is available, it will be shipped on the same flight, otherwise it will be shipped on the next available flight.

## Small Sport Equipment: \$ 25.00 (per unit)

- Sports fire arms
- Archery gear
- Bowling equipment
- Tennis gear
- Scuba diving equipment (each bag + \$ 25.00 for each empty tank)
- Skates and skate boards
- Surf boards (up to 7 feet), Wake Boards, Body Boards

- Camping gear up to 4 people

### **Large Sport Equipment: \$ 50.00 (per unit)**

- Bicycles (must reserve space at the moment of making your reservation, maximum 5 units per flight)
- Golf bags
- Fishing gear
- Inflatable Kayak
- Parachutes
- Camping gear for more than 5 people

### **Conditions**

#### **Bowling equipment**

Air Panama will transport 1 bag of bowling equipment as 1 piece of baggage with no cost as long as it complies with baggage policy. Extra weight policy applies.

#### **Scuba diving gear and equipment**

Does not apply to baggage policy.

Service charge of USD 25.00 will apply per equipment bag (fins, BCD vest, regulator, mask, Snorkel, wetsuit) and USD 25.00 for each empty oxygen tank.

#### **Tennis gear and equipment**

1 bag with 2 racquets and 6 tennis balls may be transported as part of the total baggage, baggage policy applies.

#### **Golf**

1 Golf bag per passenger as part of the luggage and extra weight policy applies.

In case the bag is an additional piece of the luggage allowed to the passenger it will have an extra charge of \$50.00.

#### **Parachutes**

Air Panama will transport parachutes as long as they meet weight and dimensions established for luggage, each parachute will occupy a slot of luggage and will be subject to extra weight/size policy.

In case the parachute represents an additional piece of luggage allowed to the passenger, it will carry a cost of \$50.00.

## Surfboards

Surfboards will be subject to overweight and oversize charges.

It does not count as part of the baggage allowance and the cost per Surfboard is \$25.00.

**It will be subject to space according to the type of aircraft that makes the flight in which the passenger will travel.**

Only up to 2 surfboards (maximum 10 kg per board) per passenger will be accepted, packed in the same protective case. Surfboards will be transported in their protective case for their safety, and with the keel removed.

Surfboards or Wakeboards over 2.13 meters (7 feet) or 84 inches (213 cm) in length.

Surf board bags or wake boards over 20 kgs (44 lbs) as checked baggage.

## Bicycles

Bicycles do not count as part of baggage. Air Panama will transport non motored bicycles for sports use or competition with an extra charge as Large Sport equipment.

Air Panama will only transport bicycles properly packed or bags with proper protection that does not allow direct contact with the plane's surface.
